- The term of **nominated members** shall be **two years** from the date of publish this notification or until further notification, whichever is earlier. The term of the **special invitee** shall be **one year**.
- The **quorum** for the meeting including the chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.

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- In **considering the grievances** before it, the SGRC shall follow principles of natural justice.
- The SGRC shall send its **report** with recommendations, if any, to the competent authority of the institution concerned and a copy thereof to the aggrieved student, preferably within a period of **15 working days** from the date of receipt of the complaint.
- Any student aggrieved by the decision of the Students' Grievance Redressal Committee may prefer an appeal to the **Ombudsperson, within a period of 15 days** from the date of receipt of such decision.
- The meetings shall be convened by the chairperson and shall be conducted in accordance with the university's rules and regulations.
- The **objective** of SGRC is to provide opportunities for redressal of certain grievances of students already enrolled in any institution, as well as those seeking admission to such institutions, and a mechanism thereto.
